The group portrays the 2nd Battery Minnesota Light Artillery which was accepted for service in the Union Army at Fort Snelling in 1862 and served until 1865. Participants will get their hands on history as they explore stations. The stations will include an Officers Station in which families will handle artifacts, flags and more; Laundress Station which showcases women's roles such as laundress, cook, and nurse; Enlisted camp Station with discussion of weapons, uniforms, and equipment; Ladies & General Station which features famous personalities including generals, spies, nurses, advocates, and soldiers; Civil War Artillery Station which showcases a full scale M1861 10 Pounder Parrott Riffle with Limber.

Gifts of Friendship from Quzhou, China and Ikata, Japan

Now on view at the Goodhue County Historical Center through September 2018.

The Red Wing Sister Cities Commission, established in 1992, promotes cultural exchange between cities of different nations to foster strengthened economics, world peace, and a greater understanding of world issues. The City of Red Wing has two official sister cities. Our relationship with Quzhou, China began in 1993 and our relationship with Ikata, Japan became official in 1995.

Teacher, student, and artist exchanges are the hallmarks of these relationships, and a collection of gifts representing over two decades of friendship and international exchange is their enduring legacy. Examples from the City of Red Wing's collection are displayed among works of art created by Red Wing residents Dawn Zero Erickson and Dan Wiemer during their exchanges to Quzhou, China.
